Student Governing Council Elections – Call for Nominations

OBJECTIVE:

To make the students participate in the development of the Institute and develop their career, personality and organizational skills through interactive programs with the faculty, administration and society.

COMPOSITION:

The Vice Chancellor will be Chief Patron and Dean, Student's Welfare will be the Patron of the Students Council. The Student Council will have an Executive Committee and Class/Section Representatives.

Election of Executive Committee:

Nominations are invited from the aspiring and eligible candidates for the following Governing Council posts. The Nominations in the prescribed pro-forma should be submitted in the Office of the Dean Student Welfare by **4:30PM** on **13-02-2020**. Application forms can be downloaded from the RGUKT Hub or can also be obtained from the Deans' office. Candidates, if they so desire, can withdraw by **7:30 PM** on 14-02-2020.

The election for Executive body will be held on **Saturday** i.e., **15-02-2020**. Timings and venue will be notified through hub before 14-02-2020.

Electoral College:

CRs of E1,E2, E3and E4 form an electoral college to elect Executive committee on prescribed date that will be notified through Hub.

Mode of elections:

Elections will be conducted in offline by Office of the Dean Student Welfare. Electoral College will franchise their vote by single transferrable vote system.

Composition of Executive Committee:

- 1. PRESIDENT: From Third year Engineering Students.
- 2. VICE PRESIDENT: From Third year Engineering Students.
- 3. GENERAL SECRETARY: From Third year Engineering Students.
- 4. JOINT SECRETARIES (1B+1G): From Second Year Engineering Students.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. He/She should be a regular student of the campus.
- 2. He/she should ensure the affirmation of having not more than 1 active remedial.
- 3. He/she should ensure the affirmation of having 75% attendance in the previous semester.

Chronology:

- 1. Election of Class Representatives will be elected by the students
- 2. Election of Executive committee by the elected Class Representatives
- 3. Nomination of Panel Chairman's by the President in consultation with Executive Committee.
