This is to inform that the End Semester Examinations (Remedial), as a onetime measure, for the PUC students of 2015 and 2016 batch have been scheduled from 06/01/2021 as per the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited.

The PUC students, who have backlogs, of the batches 2015 and 2016 can appear for PUC-I, Sem-I (Remedial) / PUC-I, Sem-II (Remedial) / PUC-II, Sem-I (Remedial) / PUC-II, Sem-II (Remedial) ESEs.

The examination pattern for theory subjects is as follows.

- a. The duration of the exam shall be 2 hours.
- b. As the maximum marks for ESE is 60, 30 marks shall be for objective type questions and 30 marks for descriptive type questions.
- c. In the descriptive section – 3 questions are to be answered out of 6 and each question carries 10 marks.
- d. The objective type section shall consist of multiple-choice questions (MCQs), fill in the blanks and short answer type questions.

The number of questions for objective type may vary from a minimum 15 to maximum 30.

The Controller of Examinations (CoE) is requested to prepare exam timetables and to take all other regular necessary actions of examination procedures to see that the exams are conducted smoothly.

The Associate Dean Student Welfare (ADSW), the Chief Warden, the Chief Security Officer are requested to take necessary actions to see that the students are accommodated as per COVID-19 guidelines issued from time to time by various authorities.
