




This is to inform that the Government of Telangana has given instructions, vide reference 2nd, to the Telangana State Board of Intermediate Education (TSBIE) to extend the benefit of grace pass marks to the students those who were absent the Intermediate Public Exams, March-2020, and exonerated by the Malpractice Scrutiny Committee, as a one-time measure.
