Subject: Introduction of BFSI Minor Degree Program for Engineering Students.

Dear Students,

This is to announce that in addition to the B.Tech program, the University is introducing Minor Degree Program in BFSI (Banking, Financial Services, and Insurance) from the A.Y.24-25 Semester-II. This program has been developed collaboratively by the BFSI consortium, the Government of Telangana, and the Telangana Council of Higher Education.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

<u>Curriculum Structure</u>: The BFSI program offers two tracks:

- 1. **Detailed Program (for E1, E2 and E3)**: A comprehensive 20-credit curriculum spread over four semesters (16 Theory + 4 Practical credits) at RGUKT Basar.
- 2. **Accelerated Program (for E4)**: One semester accelerated program with 6 hours/day course study at Remote centre followed by placements.

Teaching & Assessment: BFSI will completely take the responsibility.

<u>Timings</u>: Common slots across all the engineering departments, it will be scheduled without detrimental to the regular classwork of Engineering.

<u>Internship Opportunities</u>: Students will have the opportunity to gain practical experience through internships, enhancing their skills and employability.

Benefits: Upon completion, students will be equipped with the knowledge and skills necessary to pursue careers in the BFSI sector, with a focus on practical learning and industry-relevant expertise.

Selection Criteria: Students who meet the eligibility criteria for pre-assessment registration and subsequently qualify the pre-assessment test conducted by the BFSI would become eligible to enrol in the Minor Degree Program.

Eligibility Criteria for Pre-Assessment Registration:

- 1. Students must have at least a 7.0 GPA or 70% overall.
- 2. Students should have no backlogs.
- 3. The opportunity is open to students from any Engineering branch.

Pre-Assessment Exam Syllabus:

- 1. Logical Reasoning
- 2. Numerical Aptitude
- 3. Comprehension
- 4. Grammar
- 5. Technical Awareness
- 6. Banking & Financial Orientation
