Spell Pi:

1. As the number of registrations are more for this event, Department has decided to conduct a screening exam on 12-12-2017.

3. All the participants are expected to write value of π to as many decimals as possible in the screening exam.
4. Twenty Five candidates will be shortlisted for Final Contest and the criteria for shortlisting will be informed during the exam.

Solving SUDOKU:

TOWER OF HANOI:

1. As the registrations for this event are more, following changes have been done in the Contest.
2. The contest will be conducted on 15-12-2017 at 6.PM.in AB-I.
3. All students registered for this event has to report to those class rooms in AB-I at 5:45 PM which will be placed in Math-Club on 15-12-2017

There will be 3- levels in the competition. All levels will be conducted on same day.

Level 1: In this level participants should solve puzzle with eight discs, maximum of 25 participants will be shortlisted to next level based on solving speed.

Level 2: In this level participants should solve puzzle with Nine discs, maximum of 10 participants will be shortlisted to next level based on solving speed.

Level 3: In this level participants should solve puzzle with Ten discs, 2 participants will be awarded 1st place and 2nd place, based on solving speed. If the winners could solve it using minimum number of moves possible, then they will be getting bonus prize.
