CIRCULAR

Subject: RGUKT - Academic Section - E1 Branch Allocation (2024-25) - Instruction Manual – Reg.

Dear Students,

This is to inform all the PUC II completed students in the academic year 2023-24 and the students who were not promoted to E1 during the last academic year (AY 2022-23) and are eligible for allocation of engineering branches that the E1 branch allocation process has been started. This circular gives information about the eligibility criteria and the certificates required to claim reservation in branch allocation.

I. Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility criteria according to RGUKT- Rules and Regulations for Academic Section - Rule no. - III & X, the procedure for branch allocation is as follows:

1. As a part of 6-year integrated B.Tech program, branches of engineering will be allocated for only those who passed the 2-Years PUC with a minimum CGPA of 6 and above.
2. The allocation of the engineering branch shall be made on the choice of the students and based on their performance in the PUC as per the following procedure:
 - a. Choice of the students in order of preference going up to all 7 choices due collected online.
 - b. Student should have a minimum CGPA of ≥ 6 and put the students in order of merit as per CGPA up to Sem2 - PUC2, in each of the reserved categories and allocate the seats as per the merit order by considering the number of seats available in each of the branches for each of the categories of reservation.

3. In case of a tie on account of the same CGPA, the tie is resolved to decide the relative ranking based on the following criterion:
 - a. Average grade in Mathematics courses of the first four semesters of PUC.
 - b. Next is the average grade in Physics courses of the first four semesters of PUC.
 - c. If the tie still persists, an older candidate (based on the date of birth) is given preference over the younger.

4. The number of seats available in Engineering branches is decided considering the total number of students passing PUC with a CGPA of ≥ 6 (after taking the remedial/grade improvement examination after 1st&2nd Semesters of 2nd Year PUC into consideration) and going by the following ratio (**The following table shows the number of seats in each branch by considering the number of eligible candidates as 1000**):

Chemical Engineering	71/1000 @ 7.1 per 100 seats
Civil Engineering	143/1000 @ 14.3 per 100 seats
Computer Science and Engineering	214/1000 @ 21.4 per 100 seats
Electrical and Electronics Engineering	144/1000 @ 14.4 per 100 seats
Electronics and Communication Engineering	214/1000 @ 21.4 per 100 seats
Mechanical Engineering	143/1000 @ 14.3 per 100 seats
Metallurgical and Materials Engineering	71/1000 @ 7.1 per 100 seats

II. Information Regarding Certificates

A separate circular is given for registration of branch preferences and uploading the necessary certificates in online mode. In this regard, students are advised to keep the certificates ready by the time of activation of the registration link for submitting branch preferences.

- i. For claiming a seat in branch allocation under special reservation categories (PH/CAP/NCC/Sports), students should keep ready the certificates, issued by competent authorities.

Sports Category: Students are supposed to submit the original copies of their sports achievements / testimonials along with Form-I, II, III and IV duly certified / attested by the concerned State Sports Associations recognized by the Sports Authority of Telangana State (SATS) as per G.O.Ms.No.02 YAT&C (Sports) Dept., dated 22/09/2020

PH category- Certificate issued by District Medical Board. Candidates with 40% and above disability are only eligible.

CAP category: Certificate issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer of the concerned District in the case of Ex-Servicemen

or

CAP certificate issued by the Officer in Command / Competent Authority of the Unit in the case of Serving Armed Forces personnel, BSF and CRPF.

NCC category: Certificates issued by competent authorities.

ii. For claiming a seat in branch allocation under the reservation category (BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC, ST), students should keep ready the certificates, issued by Govt. of Telangana.
