The Betiyan Fellowship is a unique scholarship program by Procter & Gamble (P&G) in collaboration with the Centre for Civil Society (CCS). The scholarship program was launched in 2021 to encourage girl students to pursue careers in STEM fields.

The program provides **financial support**, and **mentorship** to girls pursuing STEM education, with an aim to promote their participation and growth in STEM fields

BENEFITS OF THE FELLOWSHIP

- Scholarship to cover full fees paid for the current academic year
- Mentorship opportunities with accomplished women in STEM fields
- Career counselling



ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Girl students pursuing engineering-related courses (ITIs and Renowned Engineering Colleges)
- 2. Nomination by the institution
- 3. Academic performance and attendance in the current course. In case of first year students, latest academic qualification, e.g. 10th, 12th and Graduation, will be taken into consideration
- 4. Priority to girl students from financially weaker sections.
- 5. This is a Need+Merit scholarship hence academic performance and financial need will be both considered in awarding the scholarship.
