Her study evaluated various MIMO (Multiple-Input Multiple-Output) detection techniques regarding accuracy, complexity, and spectral efficiency under realistic network conditions. It also explored innovative solutions like uplink and downlink decoupling to improve flexibility, energy efficiency, and user experience in evolving 5G and future networks.

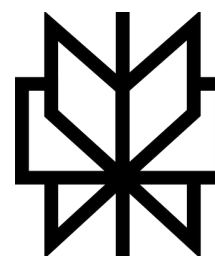
This accomplishment highlights Dr. Padmasree's dedication to advancing wireless technology and adds immense value to the academic and research environment of RGUKT Basar.

RGUKT Basar students recently had the opportunity to access Perplexity AI Pro for free as part of the Perplexity AI for India Initiative. Perplexity AI is an advanced conversational search engine that uses large language models (LLMs) to provide answers with cited sources from across the web. The Pro version offers access to superior AI models like GPT-4 Omni and Claude 3, increased daily search capacity (300 searches), and additional features including image generation and file analysis capabilities. This AI tool serves as a valuable resource for academic research, enhancing learning efficiency and work productivity for students in their educational journey.

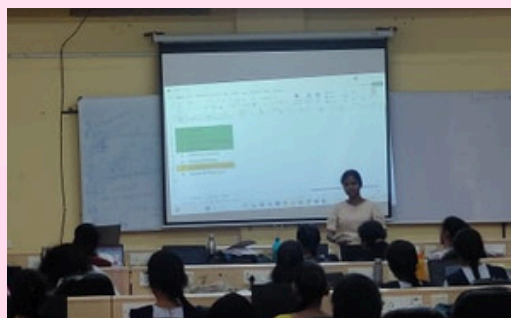
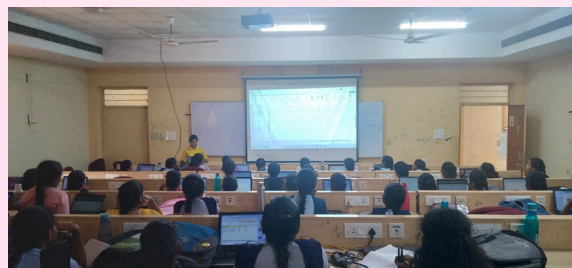
Data Science Program at RGUKT Basar
