This circular is being issued in continuation of the circular of even number dated 18/06/2021.

This is to inform that the Monthly Tests (MTs) for E4 students of AY20-21, Semester-I, have been scheduled from 01/07/2021 to 07/07/2021. The timetable of MTs has already been made available to the students on the University Hub by the Examination Section.

The number of MCQs in the MTs may vary from 10 to 20 and so will the wieightage for each question be (1 mark / 1.5 marks / 2 marks for each question).

The End Semester Examinations (ESEs) will be scheduled from 12/07/2021 and the timetable for the same will be made available soon.

The number of MCQs in the ESEs may vary from 30 to 60 and so will the wieightage for each question be (1 mark / 1.5 marks / 2 marks for each question).

The students must check their device configuration and internet speed by opening the demo quiz in department Moodle LMS site for exams.
