Since, majority of the students are not matured enough to take decisions on their own in the vast changing scenario of technology and fast life, the mentorship programme of the institute guides and counsel the students in academic, non-academic matters including personal domain to achieve their best in life.

- In particular, the system aims at addressing deficiencies in attitude, habits and knowledge of the students regarding study and learning.
- The nature of students' background i.e. catering to different socio-cultural and economic diversity necessitates mentoring being opted as one of the best practices by the university.

Objectives of the practice:

- To improve the teacher student relationship.
- To guide the students to choose right career path for job, higher studies, entrepreneurship, etc.

1. Name and contact number and residential address.
 2. If he/she faces any Language problems.
 3. If he/she suffers from any medical issues.
 4. If he/she hails from a remote village/town/metropolis.
 5. Whether he/she is enthusiastic for academics.
 6. His/her hobbies?
 7. Whether he/she is taking part in any Co-curricular/sports/cultural activities
 8. Whether he/she is able to cope up with the academics, what is their CGPA/backlogs?
 9. Attendance (rough estimate).
