Dr. G. Thirupathi Awarded Doctorate in Mathematics

Dr. G. Thirupathi, Contract Assistant Professor in the Department of Mathematics at RGUKT Basar, has been awarded a Doctorate in Mathematics by GITAM University, Hyderabad. His research, titled “A Numerical Study of Boundary Layer Flow of Heat and Mass Transfer in Non-Newtonian Fluids over a Stretching Sheet”, explores fluid dynamics and mathematical modeling with industrial applications.



Guided by Dr. K. Govardhan sir, his work offers insights into the behavior of non-Newtonian fluids and has resulted in five Scopus-indexed publications. Vice-Chancellor Prof. A. He has also published five research papers in Scopus-indexed journals, marking a significant academic milestone.

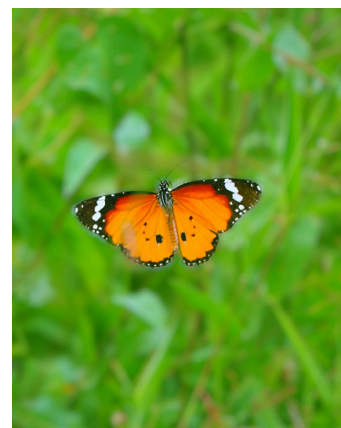

Kudos to Sanjana and Bhanuteja for representing RGUKT Basar and embracing our culture.

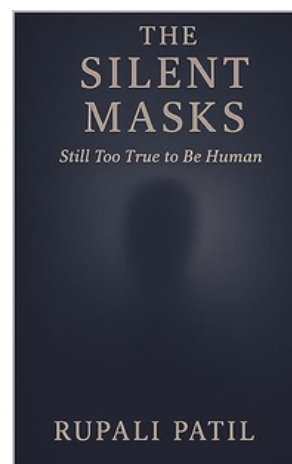
The Silent Masks: A Thoughtful Book by RGUKT Basar's Rupali Patel

We proudly announce Mahaboob Kakarada as our Leader of the Month - June, and we believe his journey will continue to inspire generations of RGUKTians to come.

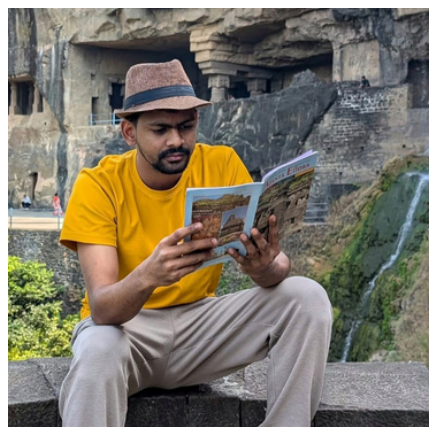

THE TECHNOLOGY TRENDS

Veo 3: The Next Big Leap in Video Technology

Veo 3 isn't just another AI tool, it's a revolution in how videos are created. Developed by Google DeepMind, Veo 3 can turn simple text prompts into high-quality, cinematic videos, complete with realistic visuals and even synchronized audio. From short films to educational content, this technology is already transforming industries. Powered by advanced transformer-based models and trained on massive datasets, Veo 3 understands motion, sound, and real-world physics to generate videos that look natural and professional.



It can produce videos up to 8 seconds long in 1080p resolution at 24 frames per second, using both text-to-video and image-to-video generation methods. Available through Google's AI Studio and Vertex AI platforms, it costs around ₹20,000 per month or pay-per-video options at roughly ₹40–60 per second of video. Beyond its creative magic, Veo 3 signals a future where AI doesn't just analyze or assist also it creates, shaping the next era of multimedia content.

Mosquito Drones: The Future of Hidden Monitoring Technology



Mosquito drones, often called micro-drones, represent one of the most fascinating developments in modern robotics and surveillance technology. These tiny, insect-sized drones are designed to mimic the flight patterns and appearance of real mosquitoes, making them almost invisible to the human eye.

Despite their small size, they are equipped with micro-cameras, sensors, and communication systems, allowing them to perform tasks like environmental monitoring, search and rescue in collapsed structures, precision agriculture, and even military surveillance.

Built using lightweight materials and powered by advanced micro-batteries, mosquito drones demonstrate cutting-edge advancements in micro-engineering and aerodynamics. While their capabilities raise exciting possibilities in science and industry, they also bring ethical concerns regarding privacy and security. As this technology develops, it is set to redefine how machines can blend into the environment to gather data or perform precise tasks in places humans cannot reach.

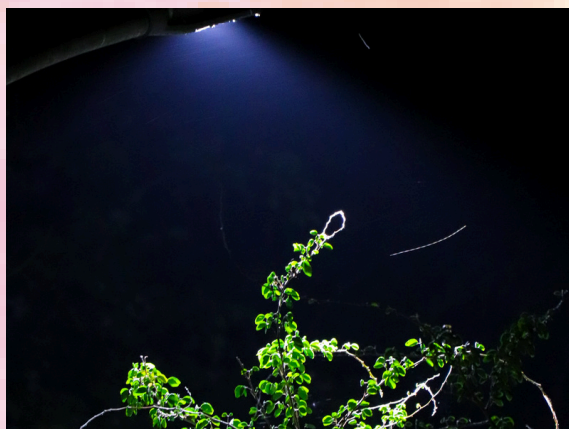

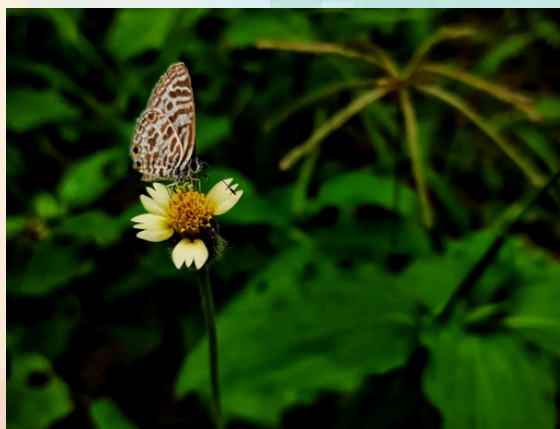
