

**Sub:** Revised grades of the punishment for the malpractice cases during all the examinations.

	<b>Nature of Malpractice</b>	<b>Recommended Punishment</b>
1.	<p>Writes Student ID/Name in the answer booklet other than at the designated place (or) Uses objectionable, abusive or offensive language in the answer paper or in letters to the examiners or writes to the examiner requesting him to award pass marks. (or) Communicating with neighbors in the examination hall (or) Possessing incriminating materials inside the examination hall (or) Possessing the answer book of another candidate (or) Passing on answer book to another student (or) Exchange of question papers, with some answers jotted down on them (or) Individual referral of material/discussion with other students, during visit outside the examination hall</p>	<p>The performance of the candidate in the particular year/semester examination in <b>all subjects including practical's</b> shall be cancelled. Additionally, the student will not be allowed for subsequent examinations.  (or)  The Disciplinary Committee shall make specific recommendations on the punishment to be awarded keeping in view the gravity of offence.</p>
2.	<p>Impersonates any other candidate in connection with the examination</p>	<p>The candidate who has impersonated shall be expelled from examination hall. He would be debarred, and his seat gets forfeited. Candidate who has been impersonated shall be cancelled in all the subjects of the examination (including practical exams and project work) already appeared and shall not be allowed to appear for Examinations of the remaining subjects of that semester. The candidate is also debarred for ONE semester from classwork and all University examinations. If the imposter is an outsider, he will be handed over to the police and a police case will be registered.</p>
3.	<p>Smuggling of answer scripts during or after the Examination (or) Misbehaves or behaves rudely with fellow student's /invigilator/ any officer on duty, refusing to obey the instructions of the Invigilator (or) Leaves the exam hall taking away answer script (or) Intentionally tears of the script or any part thereof inside or outside the examination hall.</p>	<p>Expulsion from the examination hall and Cancellation of performance in that subject and all the other subjects the candidate has already appeared including practical examinations and project work.  The candidate is also debarred for ONE semester from class work and all University examinations.</p>

4.	A candidate found in possession of <b>mobilephone/ Smart watch/ Bluetooth device</b> or any electronic gadget except non-programmable calculator.	The performance of the candidate in the particular year/semester examination in <b>all subjects including practicals</b> shall be cancelled.  The candidate shall be detained for <b>one academic year.</b>
5.	A candidate found in possession of <b>mobilephone/ Smart watch/ Bluetooth device</b> or any other electronic gadgets containing the <b>relevant material</b> of the Subject of that examination session.	The performance of the candidate in the particular year/semester examination in <b>all subjects including practicals</b> shall be cancelled.  The candidate shall be detained for <b>TWO academic years.</b>
6.	A candidate found in possession of <b>mobilephone/ Smart watch/ Bluetooth device</b> or any electronic gadgets containing the relevant material of the Subject of that examination session found <b>copied/ publicized</b> any of the <b>examination material like question/ answer through any mode of transmission.</b>	The performance of the candidate in the particular year/semester examination in <b>all subjects including practicals</b> shall be cancelled.  The candidate shall be debarred from the program. (B. Tech/ PUC)  <b>Criminal case</b> shall be booked on the student.

The disciplinary committee will be constituted by the University and shall make recommendations on the type of punishment to given to erring student.
