Subject: RGUKT-Academic Section-E1 Branch Preference Registration for Engineering Allocation (AY2026-27) – Reg.

Dear Students,

This is to inform all the PUC II completed students and the students who were not promoted to E1 during the last year AY 2025-26 and are eligible for allocation of engineering branches, that the online registration link for submitting branch preferences and uploading certificates (if any) will be kept open from 24/04/2026 to 30/04/2026, 11:59 PM.

Late Registration:

Students who fail to register before the deadline can submit a request letter along with a late fee of Rs.500 to the Academic Section on 05/05/2026, before 5:00 PM

Preference Modification:

Students who wish to change their submitted preferences can do so by submitting a request letter and paying a late fee of Rs. 500/- by mentioning their new order of preferences to the Academic section on 06/05/2026, before 5:00 PM.

No requests will be considered after 06/05/2026, 5:00 PM. Under any circumstances.

Note:

- Students are advised to carefully go through the instruction manual and familiarize themselves with all seven engineering branches before submitting their preferences.

- Students must submit their branch preferences in the order of priority. They may revise and resubmit their preferences any number of times until the final submission deadline.
- In case of multiple submissions, only the latest submitted preferences will be considered for branch allocation.
- Mutual transfers between students after branch allocation will not be permitted under any circumstances.
- It is mandatory for students to submit all seven preferences (from 1 to 7) to complete the registration process.
- Engineering branches will be allocated only to students who have successfully completed the two-year PUC with a minimum CGPA of 6.0 or above and have no backlogs.
- If a student fails to submit preferences or submits an incomplete option list, the branch will be allotted from the remaining available seats at the discretion of RGUKT.
- Students who are not allotted a branch due to having a CGPA below 6.0 may opt for a grade improvement examination or seek readmission into PUC-II.
