INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Students are allowed into the campus 25-01-2021 7:00 AM onwards, those who are appearing for PUC-1 Sem2 (B19 Batch-AY 19-20) Regular Exams and B15 & B16 batches –PUC-1 Sem2 Remedial Exams.
- 2. Group discussions and mass gathering will not be entertained.
- 3. Celebrating birthday parties, farewell parties and photo session is strictly prohibited, violations of these lead in the campus premises action will be initiated as per University rules.
- 4. You can utilize any bathroom or washroom any floor in your hostels.
- 5. Packaged and junk food is strictly not allowed in the Campus.
- 6. Students are required to stay in your allotted hostel room only.
- 7. Hostels will be sanitized twice a day and cleanliness should be maintained at washrooms. Utilize the house keeping services to maintain hygiene in your hostel room.
- 8. Any covid symptom appears, should report to the Student welfare office/Heath centre/Warden/Caretaker.
- 9. As the hostel rooms were locked for long period there may be possibility of snakes, insects inside the room. Please take care and observe the surroundings of the room while you enter the hostel room.
- 10. Always wear Mask covering nose and mouth or face shield within the campus premises.
- 11. If any student is not interested to share the room with his/her roommate, please bring to the notice of Chief warden office through mail (chiefwarden@rgukt.ac.in), so that the chief warden office can arrange the alternative and the same can be intimated through mail.

- 13. Students are not allowed enter into the Campus Supermarket (Strictly prohibited)
- 14. Students will not be allowed to leave the campus in between 5PM to 6 AM.
