Teach For India Fellow - Job Description

Teach For India Fellowship is an opportunity for India's brightest and most promising youth from the nation's best universities and workplaces to serve as full-time teachers to children from low-income communities in some of the nation's most under-resourced schools

Through this experience of teaching in classrooms and working with key education stakeholders like Students, Parents, Communities, and School Authorities, Fellows get exposed to the grassroots reality of India's education system and begin to cultivate the knowledge, skills, and mindsets necessary to attain positions of leadership in education and identify their role in building a wider movement for educational equity in the country. Fellows receive rigorous training that sets them up for success in their classrooms. Through the Fellowship, they are able to transform themselves towards leadership in educational equity.

The two-year commitment is necessary to make the impact Teach For India wishes to have on student achievement. In the 1st year, Fellows will enhance their teaching skills and establish respect and trust among various stakeholders within the School Community and the Students. This will allow Fellows to achieve significant academic gains for Students and to implement their Community/School project in the second year.



Leadership Qualities We Look For

- Deeply believe in an equitable India and excellent education for all children.
- Demonstrate leadership potential and openness to learning.
- Courage to set bold and ambitious goals.
- Demonstrate critical thinking and problemsolving abilities.

Basic Responsibilities

- Work full-time as a teacher in the assigned low income or government school.
- Design and execute strategies that will drive holistic learning outcomes in their classrooms.
- Work closely and foster strong relationships with diverse stakeholders, including Students, School Staff, Parents of the Students, Community members, and others involved in the ecosystem.
- Hold the lens of reflection, empathy, and excellence in every work.
- **Contribute to the learning and development** of the co-Fellows, peers, and the larger movement through sessions and training spaces.
- Reflect and course correct, wherever necessary, through the Leadership Development Journey.





Eligibility

- An Undergraduate/Bachelor's degree in any field by June/July 2024.
- This must be the first application to the 2024 cohort of the Teach For India Fellowship.
- Indian citizenship or an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) is mandatory.
- No prior teaching experience is required (Teach For India provides rigorous training to all Fellows to set them up for success in their classrooms.)
- Age is not a limitation.

Compensation
