Dress Code for Placements RGUKT Basar

Women

- 1. Placement team suggests choosing that style of dressing, in which you feel comfortable.
- 2. Girls can decide whether to opt for the western outfits or the traditional Indian formals.
- 3. Preferably go for Indian formals, use plain cotton sarees or Salwar Kameez with plain dupatta. Avoid low-cut necklines and tight fitting cloths. Prefer light pastel shades.
- 4. When choosing western formals, use plain light colored blouse with formal trouser or skirt of conservative length, up to the knee along with a blazer. Prefer dark shades for the trouser. In winters, a blazer or conservative suit can be used if required.
- 5. Avoid too much make-up and use simple jewellery.
- **6.** Use low heels or shoes with proper socks so that you feel comfortable. **Slippers and Sandals** are strictly not allowed.

Men

- 1. Men can wear plain light coloured formal shirt and a **mandatory tie**. Trouser should be plain and of dark shade. In winters, wear a conservative suit or blazer of solid colour.
- 2. The tie should be simple, conservative and not too flashy. It should match the colour of shirt or suit.
- 3. Shirt should be tucked-in, and shoes Dark shoes (black lace-ups are best) should be well polished. Slippers and Sandals are not allowed.
- 4. Facial hair (Moustache, Bread) must be neatly trimmed or avoid if possible.
- 5. Strictly avoid jeans, caps, T-shirts and other informal wears.

Also take care of the following things:

- 1. Use comfortable cotton clothes.
- 2. Get your cloths cleaned and ready a day before the interview.
- 3. Before going for an interview, ensure that you have all the required clothes.
- 4. Nails and teeth should be neat and clean.
- 5. Hair styling should be appropriate and neat.
- 6. Shoes should be polished.
- 7. Body-odour is a strict No. Use a deodorant (Minimal cologne or perfume) after taking bath if required.
- 8. Never wear sneakers, noisy shoes or very high heels for an interview.
- 9. Never bring chewing-gum, coffee, soda, Ipod etc. to the interview.
- 10. Wear a smile on the face and look confident. Body language MATTERS.
